Spanish work - Mrs. J. C. Reynolds.

Text Isa. 53:1

If we would close our eyes and listen to the report of these Spanish people for the last 3 yrs. we would think we were in the heart of Africa, India or China etc. There are now 50000 Spanish people in S. Cal.

In 1834 Mexico became a republic. Be interested and have more love to these people. Most of them can neither write nor read, and of late have still used the old fashioned plow; but have been successful in raising the foods. Their religion is & will be Roman Catholic. This religion ^{does not} gives them liberty or peace or joy.

Doors are being opened to the evangelization of this people.

Mexico is the finest built city in America. The Cathedral is 600 ft. long, 430 ft. wide, built in Catholic style. The altar is beautiful.

How we long to tell them of Jesus, whose blood can wash away each stain, & cleanse us from all sin. Tell them of this great salvation! They preach no religion that can save us from sin. Jesus opened wide the fountain. These people ask, "Does it keep?" We have proved it, over & over.

Mrs. Mc Reynolds says they (she & others) were born to this work about 3 yrs. ago. Their work has prospered & now need more room. Want to take the children in house them to keep them from evil influences. Have about 15 or 20 girls. Trusting in the Lord, and believe he will answer prayer.

We have S. S. Sunday P. M. & then spend 2 hrs. in open air service, also have service in the evening until about 9:30. Preach Jesus, and him crucified. People become justified & then

sanctified. They all have a testimony.
Have about 20 members. Among the 100's
that have been saved in the last 3 yrs.

The Lord has infinite possibilities
among these people when we keep
humble. It is impossible to tell all
the ignorance, degradation and suffering
of these people. It is like another world!
Population consist mostly of rich, hard-
hearted, haughty aristocrats on the
other hand slaves. Men do the work
there that a beast of burden does in
our country.

Take the child, it has no home - but
hardly any clothing to wear, grows up
without any home, without knowing
anything about the church, school, the
Bible, blessed songs, and salvation as
we do. Have no liberty. Children are

kidnapped but nothing is done. They are waiting for the Gospel. They need salvation. The Lord is preparing us. There is a mighty outlook. God help us to be true to our calling.

India - ^{my} Mrs. La Fontaine.
Our God & His Truth is marching on.

The degradation of India is not comparable; but God is going to do mighty works. Received \$7,125 for a mission in India. Pay our money along holiness lines & work. There is a great lack of holiness preaching.

18 yrs ago Sister Banarjee started her work here. She always had a longing in her heart. Sister Eaton helped in this work. After she met the Nazarene People, Mrs. Banarjee would say, "after long waiting the Lord has

given her the people she promised her." "Praise
the Lord for the People of the Nazareth Church.

She is saved and sanctified, & doing a
wonderful work in India. She is always
in great danger of her life, so she needs earnest
prayers. The children suffer much.

May the Lord be with her and her
earnest work.
